



CognEYEzant: How to Draw an Eye in 5 Steps




- **Begin by drawing upper eyelid**



- **Draw iris**
(a bit more than a half circle)



- **Draw lower lid**
(begin line on outer corner of eye, curving slightly, continue line to just before corner of eye)



- **Draw corner of eye**
(or "caruncle": remnant of our reptilian eye)
- **Draw pupil**
(leave room for "shine" on eye)



- **Draw eyelashes**
(on top and bottom lids)
- **Flesh out lower lid**
(add line in outer, lower corner of eye, as pictured)
- **Draw crease above eye**
- **Add line for "bag" under eye**
(optional)
